

TENDER NOTICE

RE - ADVERTISEMENT

The Kenya Red Cross Society (KRCS) is a humanitarian organisation in Kenya created in 1965 through the Act of Parliament, Cap 256 of the Laws of Kenya. As a voluntary organization, the society operates through a network of eight Regions and 62 Branches spread throughout the country. The society is a member of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, the largest humanitarian relief Movement represented in 187 countries worldwide. Its mission is to be the leading humanitarian organization in Kenya that is self-sustaining, delivering excellent quality services of preventing human suffering to the most vulnerable in the community.

As part of the drought response and mitigation initiatives, the society plans to invest in medium to long term sustainable projects that focus on food security and livelihood improvement in Turkana North, East Pokot and Moyale.

The Society calls for Tenders from qualified consultants in the following areas:

1. ENVIRONMENTAL AND SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

Overall Responsibility:

A consulting firm or institution will conduct a detailed Environmental and Social Impact assessment in one of the 3 proposed areas in Turkana North, East Pokot and Moyale

Specific Objectives

- Identify positive and negative impacts and appropriate interventions during construction and operation.
- Collect and collate baseline socioeconomic data of the project area and potential impact expected from project construction, implementation and operation.
- Develop an environmental monitoring program (EMP) during construction and operation and present plans to minimize, mitigate, or eliminate negative effects and impacts and describe how this plan will be implemented.
- Identify and contact stakeholders, facilitate public consultation and workshops at an appropriate time in the assignment schedule.
- Gather and provide any other data and information that will be useful for the study.

Deliverables.

A final report including conclusions and suggested recommendations for the effective and efficient implementation of activities.

Qualification

The lead consultant should possess a minimum of post graduate degree in Natural Resources Management, Civil Engineering or related field and must be registered and licensed by NEMA to conduct Environmental Impact Assessments (EIA). The proposed team should also possess relevant public health/sociology/agronomy/research analyst background with adequate relevant experience.

2. DESIGN, DRAWINGS AND BILL OF QUANTITIES FOR WATER FACILITIES

Kenya Red Cross Society calls for Tender for preparation of Designs, Drawings and Bill of Quantities for 5 sand dams in Turkana North District and 1 water pan in East Pokot District.

Overall Responsibility:

The consultant shall be responsible for assessments and preparation of designs, drawings and Bill of Quantities for 5 sand dams in 4 locations in Turkana north, namely; Lagga Kotome (2), Ekicheles (1), Longolemar (1), and one location East Pokot, namely, Kollowa.

Specific Objectives

- Carry out detailed site measurements and tests
- Assess the water demand for each system
- Analyze soil formations (dam sites geophysical and geotechnical data)
- Design technically sound water supply systems which would include the source development, abstraction, transmission and storage relevant to the proposed intervention and geographic location.

Deliverables.

- A final design report for each of the water system
- A full set of detailed drawing for all the water systems
- A full set of priced Bills of Quantities for each system, complete with a schedule of technical specifications the contractor should adhere to.

Qualification

The consultant shall have a team of technically competent civil engineers and surveyors.
